The Programme will offer **short observership placements** in various psychiatric institutions across Europe, allowing applicants to broaden their clinical, research and/or teaching skills and knowledge, and become familiar with different mental health systems in Europe. Five placements are currently being offered in Hungary, Italy, Spain, Sweden, and the United Kingdom.

**For successful applicants, EPA is pleased to offer a scholarship of 800€ per applicant to help with travel, accommodation and other expenses.**
