# Course on Leadership and Professional Development for Young Psychiatrists

Jakarta – Indonesia, 11-13 November 2018

This course will be organized by Indonesian Psychiatric Association and the Indonesian Early Career Psychiatrist Association in collaboration with the Association for the Improvement of Mental Health Programs, in Jakarta-Indonesia 11-13 November 2018. The course will be directed by Professor Norman Sartorius working with an international faculty including Professor Mohan Isaac from University of Western Australia.

This course will aim to enable the participants to acquire skills that will help them to make an effective scientific presentation, prepare a poster describing a study or a program, select and read scientific papers, select a subject for research, prepare a scientific paper or report, chair a meeting, prepare their curriculum vitae and decide on priorities for themselves and their services.

The participants are expected to make a brief (8 minutes) presentation of a subject of their choice and bring along a poster on the same or other subject.

Candidates must have a good command of English, should be in advanced stage of postgraduate training or have graduated not more than 5 years ago. There is no limit to the number of applications per country.

Approximately 16 awardees (10 International awardees and 6-8 Indonesian awardees) will be selected to take part in the course.

The Indonesian young psychiatrist organization with the support of the Lundbeck Neuroscience Institute will provide successful candidates with single room accommodation for 3 nights (4 days) and meals (3 meals and 2 times snacks) and a cultural dinner.

The participants will receive a certificate of attendance, and a copy of the materials presented during the course.
