

CAP Section - IT Position

The European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS) is the oldest medical organisation in Europe with a current membership of 37 countries. Its structure consists of a council, responsible for and working through 43 specialist sections and their European Boards.

The Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Section was established in 1994 and organises an annual physical meeting where child and adolescent psychiatrists delegates from each country meet to discuss topics relevant to our speciality and work together towards a common goal.

The UEMS - CAP section, together with the European Federation of Psychiatric Trainees are now offering a one-year position for a certified European trainee with the following requirements and benefits:

Requirements:

- Be a psychiatric trainee in any European country at the time of applying for the position
- Have 2-4 free hours per month available to work on the UEMS - CAP section webpage
- Present a report of the annual work on the webpage at the annual UEMS - CAP section meeting
- Have previous knowledge or experience of webpages/IT
- Fluent level of written and spoken English language
- Have an interest in working in a European environment and a commitment to the UEMS and its endeavours

Benefits:

- The UEMS will provide funding for travel, to include flights and accommodation, for the applicant to be able to attend the UEMS annual meeting in the current year
- The level of funding will not exceed 400 Euros
